- Seek new vendors for relationships that will innovate and propel our success. Evaluate and renegotiate vendor contracts, create a monitored contract vendor system.
- Recruiting people with new experiences and talents to become HWBA Members that can assist us with our initiatives and to build a pipeline for Board Directorship.
- Management compensation program with performance KPIs.
- New Resident and Family Handbook and new HNRC Employee Handbook.
